In 2009, while nursing my baby, I discovered the lump. I knew it wasn't milk... Within a month I had undergone a mammography, biopsy, diagnosis, and lymphectomy with Dr. (now) Prof. Dan Hershko. It was cancer, and I was referred to Rambam Health Care Campus and started chemotherapy. Then I learned I have the breast cancer gene... Not wanting to gamble with my life, I underwent bilateral breast removal and reconstruction.

The oncological care I received at Rambam was empathetic, professional, comforting, and supportive—they sought to leave no door open for cancer's return. I viewed my life as a major battle, not as a sickness, nor as my destiny. This is how I'm continuing to live my life. Then, and now, four years later, I am victorious.
